

Open letter to the United Nations, International Committee of the Red Cross and Government of Spain

The signatory organizations, aware of international legislation, of the role of guarantors of the Human Rights Charter (UN), of the Geneva Conventions (ICRC) and de jure administering power (Government of Spain),

Faced with the continuous violations of human rights by the Moroccan occupying power on the Sahrawi activists in the occupied territories of Western Sahara, especially after of the ceasefire in November last year,

The Western Sahara is a territory pending decolonization protected by MINURSO as a United Nations mechanism on the ground, and due to the validity of the Geneva Conventions in the occupied territories with civilian populations by a third party,

Known the special situation of the activist Sultana Jaya and her family, victims of all kinds of harassment and aggression and currently suffering from the covid-19 disease;

We demand that these organizations intervene before the Moroccan regime to demand the immediate attention of Sultana and her family affected by the covid and the immediate cessation of the attacks against the Sahrawi civilian population, as well as the scrupulous application in the occupied territory of Western Sahara of the UN Charter of Human Rights and the Geneva Conventions.
